Because the quality of our decisions determines the quality of our lives...
and because sometimes we are not good decision makers...
we are pre-deciding ahead of time certain actions to help us decide who we're going to be.

Pre-decision #1: "I AM READY" TO RESIST TEMPTATION

1. Pre-decide to move the line to stay far away from sin.
2. Pre-decide to plan your escape to get out of temptation.

Pre-decision #2: "I AM CONSISTENT" IN LIFE

1. Pre-decide to "start with the why" to understand proper motivation for being consistent.
2. Pre-decide to embrace the process instead of obsessing about the goal.

Pre-decision #3: "I AM DEVOTED" TO GOD

1. Pre-decide to consistently study God's Word (the Bible).
2. Pre-decide to consistently pray and to practice fasting on occasion.
3. Pre-decide to join in Christian fellowship through worship, small groups, and classes.
4. Pre-decide to receive Holy Communion as often as available.

Pre-decision #4: "I AM GENEROUS" IN MY HEART

1. Pre-decide to plan to be generous instead of just doing it spontaneously.
2. Pre-decide to always round up (go above and beyond) without holding back.

Pre-decision #5: "I AM FAITHFUL" IN EVERYTHING

1. Pre-decide to add value in every interaction in how you treat people.
2. Pre-decide to see every resource as an opportunity to multiply what God has entrusted to you.
3. Pre-decide to be obedient in responding to God's promptings throughout life.

Pre-decision #6: "I AM A FINISHER" TO THE END

1. Pre-decide to do what God has called you to do, to run the race God has called you to run.
2. Pre-decide to take the next step in finishing your race today.
